Please note that security passes can only be collected by the applicant. Please bring one form of identification with you (passport or driving licence). Conference pass fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Accommodation

Admission

The doors to the Conference Centre will be open at 07.00 daily. Entry can only be obtained via the search channel located on Centenary Square (off Broad Street). Entry to the Hyatt Regency Birmingham hotel is via the search channel located on Bridge Street (outside the main entrance to the hotel).

At peak times, some minor delays may be inevitable to allow for the appropriate security checks. It will speed up the checks considerably if the carrying of bags, large handbags or briefcases is kept to a minimum.

Luggage may not be brought into the secure zone under any circumstances. A left luggage facility is provided on the last day of Conference (Wednesday 10 October). There will be a charge for using this service – see Left Luggage on page 147.

Balloons

Under no circumstances can balloons be taken into the Secure Island Site or the Conference Hall.

Business Reception Desk

The ICC has a Business Centre situated near the Symphony Hall Box Office in The Mall (level 3). Opening hours are 08.00 - 18.00 each day of the Conference. Services include: faxing, binding, laminating, photocopying, printing (black & white and colour) and scanning.

Car Parks

Car parks are clearly signposted in the City centre. The nearest parking facility will be at the Brindley Drive multi-storey car park on Cambridge Street and the NIA car park on Sheepcote Street. These are both 'pay and display'. The nearest 'pay and exit' car park is at Brindley Place (situated behind the Novotel hotel on Brunswick Street). These and other parking sites can be found on the City map on page 153.

There will be NO PARKING in the immediate vicinity of either The ICC or the Hyatt Regency Birmingham hotel.

Blue badge parking bays are shown on the Birmingham City Centre map on page 153. Parking for blue badge holders will also be at the Brindley Drive multi-storey facility on Cambridge Street. For further information on badge holder parking, call 0121 303 7617.

Cash

An ATM for cash withdrawals will be available at the Post Office Counter Ltd stand in the Market Place area in Hall 3 (level 4), numbers M31 & M32.

Cloakroom Facilities

These are available at The ICC in The Mall (level 3) at a charge of £1.00 per item. Please note: luggage may not be brought into the venue under any circumstances.

Left luggage facilities are available on the last day of Conference. Please see Left Luggage on page 147.

Conference Relay & TV Monitors

During Conference session times Hall 1 (access via level 4) will be used as the relay room, which will show live coverage. Delegates will not be able to take food or beverage items into this hall.

Screens will be situated throughout the complex and at the following catering points for you to view live sessions and Conference information: Starbucks Conference Internet Hub & seating zone (level 3), Cafe Vité seating zone (level 3) and catering seating zones in Registration (level 4), Hall 3 (level 4) and Hall 3 Gallery (level 5).

Conference Security Passes

Photographic passes are the only form of identification that will enable you to enter the Conference secure island site. The pass is attached to the West Midlands Police security leaflet. Please ensure you read this. Passes must be worn at all times whilst you are in The ICC or the Hyatt Regency Birmingham hotel, but must be removed as soon as you leave the secure island site.

Under no circumstances will anyone be admitted to these buildings, unless wearing a valid Conference security photographic pass from 12.00 on Saturday 6 October onwards.

Conference Video Wall, sponsored by The Telegraph

The Conference Video Wall is situated in Hall 3 Gallery (level 5) at The ICC. You will be able to view the exhibition area and gain access to Hall 3. Delegates will be able to relax, eat and drink whilst watching live Conference sessions. The ICC Café Vite Express facilities will also be available in this area. You will be able to pick-up your complimentary copy of The Telegraph from this location.

Cycle Parking

Use of cycle parking stands outside The ICC and the Hyatt Regency Birmingham will be suspended for the duration of the event. Under no circumstances can bicycles be chained to any of the security fencing. Alternative cycle parking can be found throughout the City centre. Please see map on page 153 for parking sites.

Exhibition

This is an important and major part of the Conference with many commercial companies, organisations and charities in attendance. They would like to speak about their product, service, issue and/or current campaign. Please ensure that you visit the exhibitors in The Mall (level 2 & 3), Registration (level 4) and Hall 3 (level 4). The general exhibition will again contain The Party Zone (Hall 3, level 4), the Start-Up Hub (Hall 3, level 4) and the Social Action Zone (The Mall, level 2).

The Party Zone brings together the Party and all its affiliated groups and organisations to display and showcase the work of the Party and its volunteers throughout the country. The Start-Up Hub at stands 41 - 44 in Hall 3 (level 4) will showcase new UK-based companies and entrepreneurs to present their ideas and concepts at Conference. It is sponsored by Fujitsu, British Venture Capital Association (BVCA) and Inmarsat. Finally, the Social Action Zone at stand 13 in The Mall (level 2) will be highlighting the Party's Conference projects this year.

Facilities for Disabled Visitors at the Hyatt Regency Birmingham

There is ramp access from lower to upper lobby area and Bar Pravda. There is disabled lift access from the upper lobby to Aria Restaurant. Washroom facilities are available on the ground floor of the hotel.

Access to The ICC is via the bridge link on level B.

Facilities for Disabled Visitors at The ICC

The ICC is fully accessible to wheelchair users via ramps or lifts. Tactile signage is fitted to the majority of lifts and assistance dogs are most welcome.

Each hall has its own toilets dedicated for use by disabled delegates.

Access to the Hyatt Regency Birmingham hotel is via Symphony Hall Foyer level 5.

Facilities for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Visitors at The ICC

An infra red system in Halls 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 & 11 is in operation. Representatives will need to collect a pack from the Business Centre which consists of a receiver box and lanyard. The user enters the hall, fits the lanyard around their neck and plugs it into the pack. Then, after switching their hearing aid to the 'T' position all they need to do is point the pack to the front of the room and press the start button to receive the sound signal.

Symphony Hall uses infra red packs, but on a different frequency and therefore you will need different packs (also available from the Business Centre).

Registered British Sign Language Interpreters will be positioned within both Symphony Hall and Hall 1 conference sessions.

Halls 3 & 4 have an induction loop system. Hearing aids should be switched to the 'T' position.

Fringe Information Point

Look out for the Giant Handbook in The Mall (Level 3) in The ICC, to view the latest fringe listing information. You can check and search for specific events, create a personalised list, email it, add it to your electronic calendar or simply print out your list there and then. Hyatt Regency Birmingham Hotel & Spa Facilities

The hotel is linked to The ICC via the bridge link on level B of the hotel (and via level 5 of The ICC). Left Luggage

A left luggage facility close to the Conference Centre is available for delegates who have to check out of their hotels on the last day of the Conference. This will be situated in the House of Sports complex, Broad Street, Birmingham (opposite the Hyatt Regency Birmingham hotel) and will be open from 08.00 to 17.00 on Wednesday 10 October only. There will be a nominal fee for this service.

This includes both external and internal areas of the complex. A dilapidation charge will be levied against any organisation or individual responsible for 'fly-posting'.

No distribution of leaflets is permitted between the search channel and entrance areas or near the entrance and exit doors to the hotel or conference venue. There is also no literature distribution allowed on any level of both complexes. Any unauthorised materials will be removed. We thank you in advance for your co-operation. Medical

The majority of full-time security staff at The ICC are 'first response' trained (ie trained in basic first aid including CPR). A core of full-time security staff are on-site 24 hours per day.

You may also notify an ICC Host or Party Steward if you require medical assistance.

The nearest chemist is a two-minute walk away, across the canal at Brindleyplace.

Mobile Telephones

Free mobile charging points are located at stand 12 (The Mall, level 3) and stand 34 (Hall 3, level 4). These are provided by Everything Everywhere (Orange and T-Mobile).

During Conference sessions the use of mobile phones is strictly forbidden. Please switch off your mobile phone whilst in the main Conference auditorium.

Mobility Scooters

We are pleased to offer complimentary mobility hire during this event.

This is intended for people of all ages who may have difficulty walking distances for periods of time. We can provide fully electronic mobility scooters that are ideal for both indoor and outdoor use. They are suitable for users up to 136kg (300lbs) in weight.

The mobility scooters are designed to be driven on footpaths (pavements) and to cross roads but not meant for road use (however, they do meet the current pavement speed legislation).

Security

Your full co-operation is sought in the following:

- Please wear your Conference security photographic pass at all times and ensure that it is clearly visible.
- Please take care of your Conference security pass, especially when outside the secure area, when it should not be visible.
- If you lose your pass or experience any problems, please report to the Accreditation Office at Quayside Tower, 5th Floor, 252-260 Broad Street, Birmingham B1 2HF. Tel: 020 7099 9639.
- Do not bring any luggage into the Conference venues. It is advisable to keep essential bags, small parcels or briefcases to a minimum to reduce delays as you arrive at the venue.
- It will help if you remove any non-essential metal items from pockets and bags before passing through search channels.
- If you bring any electrical item into the secure island site, you will be asked by security personnel to demonstrate it in operation.
- Your full co-operation with police, G4S security staff, stewards and hosts will help to reduce any delays or problems which may arise as a result of necessary security measures.
- If you have any urgent queries or concerns about any aspect of the security arrangements, please refer these to a senior steward or police officer, so that your concerns may be followed up immediately.
- Please read the Security Advice leaflet by the West Midlands Police, issued with your Conference security pass.

Smoking Areas

Smoking is not permitted anywhere within The ICC or the Hyatt Regency Birmingham venues.

Those wishing to smoke should go to the designated smoking areas at either Centenary Square or Canal Side at The ICC. At the Hyatt Regency Birmingham smokers should go left out of the main doors at the front of the hotel.

Or you may call the Chiltern Business Travel team on 0121 654 2115. These tickets won't run out and they will not charge a booking fee. To book this £25.00 travel ticket, the cut-off date is five days before travel to ensure your tickets arrive in time.

The Chiltern Business Travel team will also be able to help out with any group booking requirements and may be able to offer you further discounts for groups of four or more. For the £25.00 tickets to have 'anytime' validity, simply show your ticket along with your Conference ID and you can choose to travel on any Chiltern Mainline service during the Conference without ticket restrictions.

BIRMINGHAM REGIONAL MAP

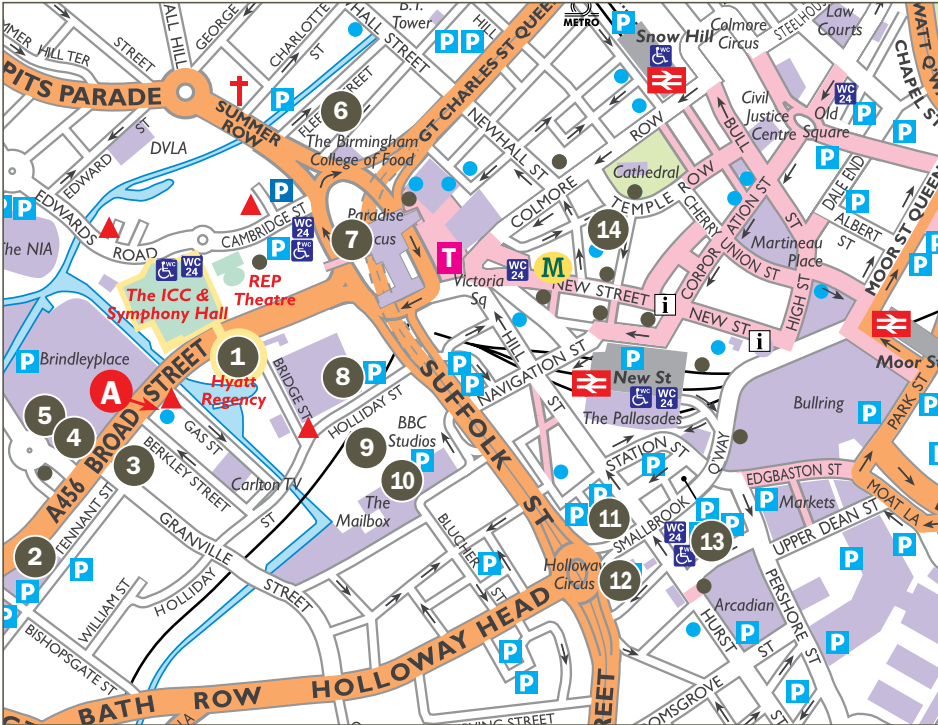
